- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 (one) role of masking tape or duct tape
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 (one) package (150 count) of college ruled, 3 hole lined paper
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 (three) pocket folders
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 (two) 12 pack of pencils
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 (two) old magazines (for projects)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4 (four) spiral notebooks. (150 pages and different colors)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 (two) folders (For homework)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 (one) small calendar or notebook to keep track of homework assignments
